On this field trip, the **Adelaide Fungal Studies Group** will lead us on a Fungi Foray.

On the foray we will look for fungi, note the characteristics that help in identifying them, collect representative specimens, and take them to a collection point (The Volunteers' Centre) at around noon. There we will look at them in further detail.



The **Fungi Foray** is always a lot of fun and learning - and you will be amazed at the variety of fungi that we will discover and identify.

Upon arrival at the Park, let the person on the gate know that you are part of our group. We will have free entry to the park so you will not need to pay for your car. Please cut out the sign below and put in on your dashboard when you arrive. Then drive to the **Volunteers' Centre**, ready for us to start at 10am.

Please try to arrive 15 minutes beforehand as we will be setting off in convoys to go to




various sites where we will be collecting fungi. If you are running late, there will be someone at the Centre to direct you to one of the general areas where we will be.
